Procurement governed by the European Spallation Source ERIC procurement rules (as of 1 October 2015)

Purpose

To explain how ESS ERIC conducts procurement, providing transparency on tender procedures, rights and obligations of suppliers, including a review and appeal procedure

Scope and objectives



Following the EU treaty principles of:

• Transparency, proportionality, mutual recognition, equal treatment and non-discrimination

Apply to all contracts for pecuniary interest for the provision of goods, works and services between ESS and a 3rd party [supplier]

Promoting the objectives of:

· Value for money, publicity, integrity, innovation, sustainability


The ILO Network

Management of ILO Network
