

Professor Metin Heper, Ph.D., Syracuse University, USA, is Director of Political Science Research Program of the İhsan Doğramacı International Advanced Studies Center, Bilkent University, Ankara and an Honorary member of the Turkish Academy of Sciences. He acted as Dean at Koç University (Istanbul) and Bilkent University, as Associate Rector at the Middle East Technical University (Ankara) and Bilkent University, and as a member of the Executive Committee of the Scientific and Technological Research Council of Turkey (TÜBİTAK). Professor Heper had been a Research Fellow at Harvard University, Lester Martin Research Fellow at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem, Fulbright Scholar and Visiting Professor at the University of Connecticut, Simon Senior Research Fellow at the University of Manchester, U.K., Madeleine Haas Russell Visiting Professor of Non-Western and Comparative Politics at Brandeis University, and Fulbright Scholar and Visiting Professor at Princeton University. Some of Professor Heper's articles appeared in such journals as *Turkish Studies*, *Middle East Journal*, *Middle Eastern Studies*, *British Journal of Middle Eastern Studies*, *Muslim World*, *Encyclopedia of Islam*, *Jerusalem Journal of International Relations*, *European Studies Journal*, *Journal of Political and Military Sociology*, *Armed Forces and Society*, *International Social Science Journal*, *Administration and Society*, *International Review of Modern Sociology*, *Comparative Studies in Society and History*, *Journal of International Affairs*, *International Journal of Political Education*, *Governance*, *Government and Opposition*, *Journal of Democracy*, *International Political Science Review*, *Comparative Politics*, *Political Science Quarterly*, *Comparative Political Studies*, *Conflict, Security and Development*, *Cambridge Review of International Affairs*, *Democratization*, *Third World Quarterly* and *Nations and Nationalism*. Professor Heper is co-editor of such volumes as *Islam and Politics in the Modern Middle East*, *The Routledge Handbook of Modern Turkey*, *Institutions and Democratic Statecraft*, editor of such volumes as *The State and Public Bureaucracies: A Comparative Perspective*, and author of *Historical Dictionary of Turkey* (first, second, third editions), *The State Tradition in Turkey*, *İsmet İnönü: The Making of a Turkish Statesman*, and *The State and Kurds in Turkey: The Question of Assimilation*. Professor Heper is presently working on a book for I.B. Tauris, London, tentatively entitled "Secularism, Islam, and Democracy in Turkey: Cognitive

Misconceptions and Enduring Conflict” as author and on the fourth edition of *Historical Dictionary of Turkey*, as co-author.
