

AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TURKEY
AND
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF
PAKISTAN REGARDING TECHNICAL AND SCIENTIFIC
COOPERATION

The Government of the Republic of Turkey and the Government of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan basing themselves on the friendly and brotherly relations existing between the two countries and their peoples, desiring to strengthen those relations, considering their common interest in promoting the Technical and Scientific Development of their countries, reaffirming their determination to contribute to the strengthening of world peace, have agreed as follows:

ARTICLE 1

1- The contracting parties shall cooperate in the fields and relevant technical matters mentioned in Article 2 below.

2- The details of cooperation shall be determined by separate arrangements to be concluded between the contracting parties.

ARTICLE 2

The fields of cooperation are mentioned below:

- Agriculture and Animal Husbandry
- Health
- Industry ✓

ARTICLE 3

The cooperation in the fields mentioned in the Article 2 of this Agreement shall cover the following subjects:

- (1) The parties shall exchange Experts and Scientists in order to assist and consult each other in the field of Science and technology.
- (2) The parties shall jointly organize Seminars, Symposia and Conferences in Turkey and in Pakistan.
- (3) The parties shall mutually provide Education, Research and on the Job-Training facilities for each other's Scientists.
- (4) The parties shall exchange information through exchange of Scientific and Technical documents.
- (5) The parties shall explore possibilities of developing Joint Scientific and Technological Projects.

ARTICLE 4

The parties shall prepare annual programs in order to implement this Agreement. A Joint Committee may be formed for the preparation of the said programs.

ARTICLE 5

The sending party shall meet the travel costs and subsistence allowances of the Trainees, Experts and Scientists and adequate accommodation shall be provided for the same within the possibilities of the recipient party. Scholarships/ subsistence grants may also be offered, wherever possible. *(Signature)*

The parties shall particularly promote through diplomatic channels, cooperation among Universities, Educational, Training and Technical Institutions of their respective countries.

ARTICLE - 7

Each of the contracting party herewith undertakes not to transfer any information generated through implementation of this Agreement to a third party without prior permission of the other.

ARTICLE - 8

The inventions made as a result of the activities within the framework of this Agreement shall be subject to the patent rights and revealing of information concerning these to a third party shall be subject to the permission of the party having the patent rights.


ARTICLE - 9

This Agreement shall enter into force on the date of exchange of the documents of ratification and shall be renewed automatically unless one of the contracting parties notified in writing, the other party of its wish to terminate or modify this Agreement six months prior to the date of its expiry. *Dr.* *7* *Chh.*

In case of termination of this Agreement the Articles of the Agreement shall continue to be valid for the projects uncompleted on the date of termination until the said projects are fully completed.


