## Overview

- **Size:** 1,007.47 km<sup>2</sup> (1% of country area, 1.6 times the size of Seoul)
- **Population:** 2.71 million (third largest, after Seoul and Busan)
- **Features:**
  - International city with world-class airport and seaports
    - Incheon International Airport (opened 2001) handles 28 million passengers, and 2.33 million tons of cargo per year
  - Major west coast business city: contains large national/local industrial complexes
  - City of culture and history: Many historic buildings, museums, and scenic islands



Incheon

- **Budget:** KRW 5.511 trillion (2008)
- **Economy**
  - GRDP: KRW 40.607 trillion (4.7% of national total)
  - Industrial complexes/companies: 9 complexes/ 6,027 companies
  - Industrial structure: tertiary – 68.2% secondary - 31% primary – 0.7%
  - Workforce: 1.31 million

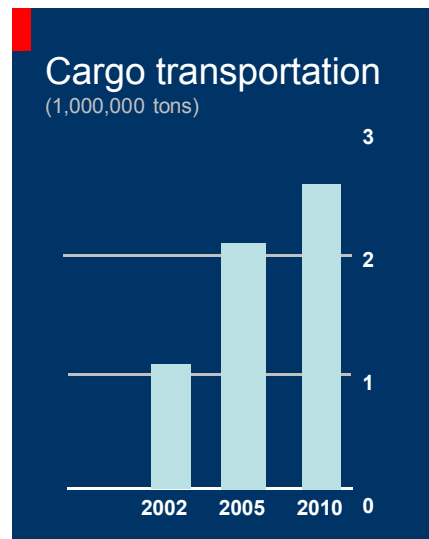
- Located between China and Japan

### Northeast Asia's Hub Airport: World's No. 2 in Cargo Volume

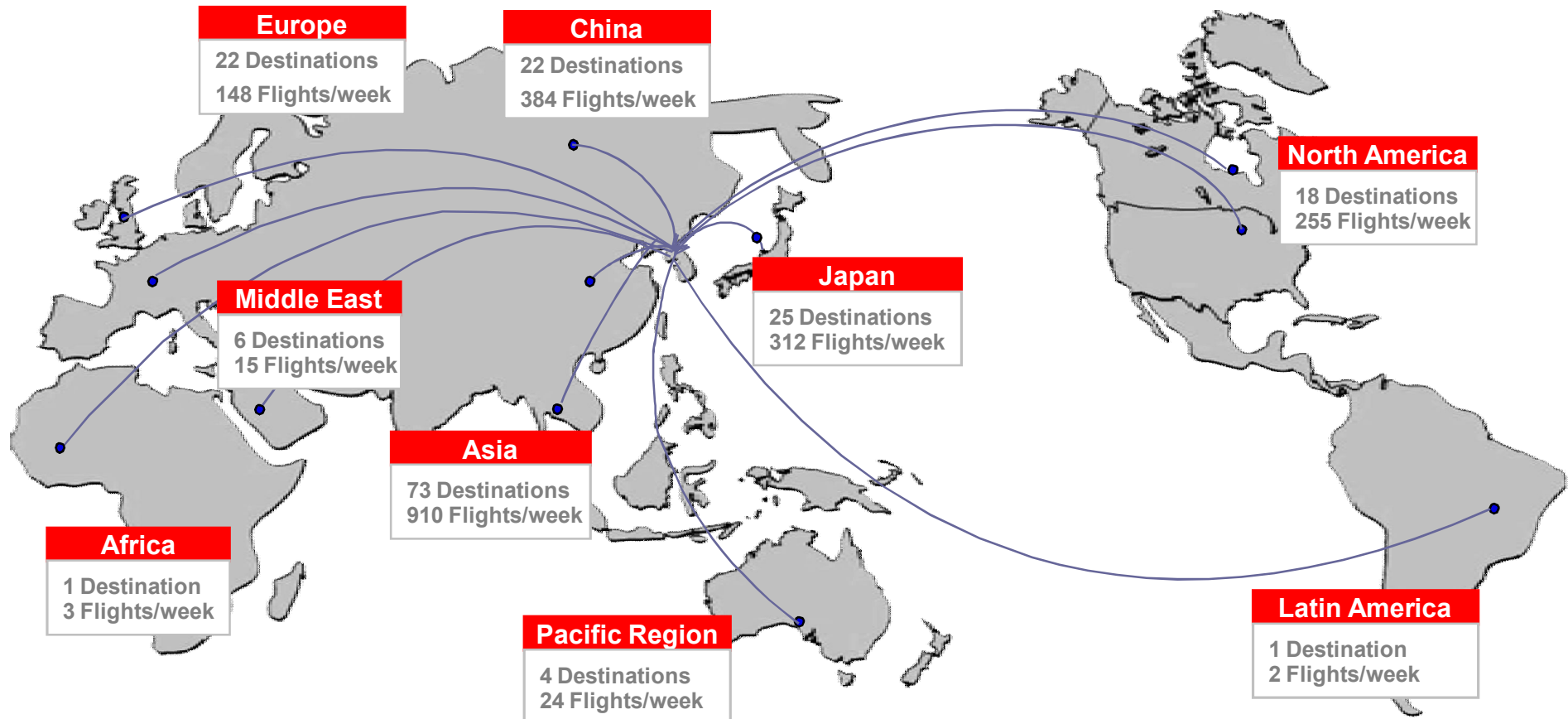


- Opened in 2001, IIA is Asia's largest airport
- Global ranking 2nd in cargo volume, 10<sup>th</sup> in passenger traffic (center of logistics industry)
- 2 runways - 3 more planned

## 3. Port of Incheon

Center of international

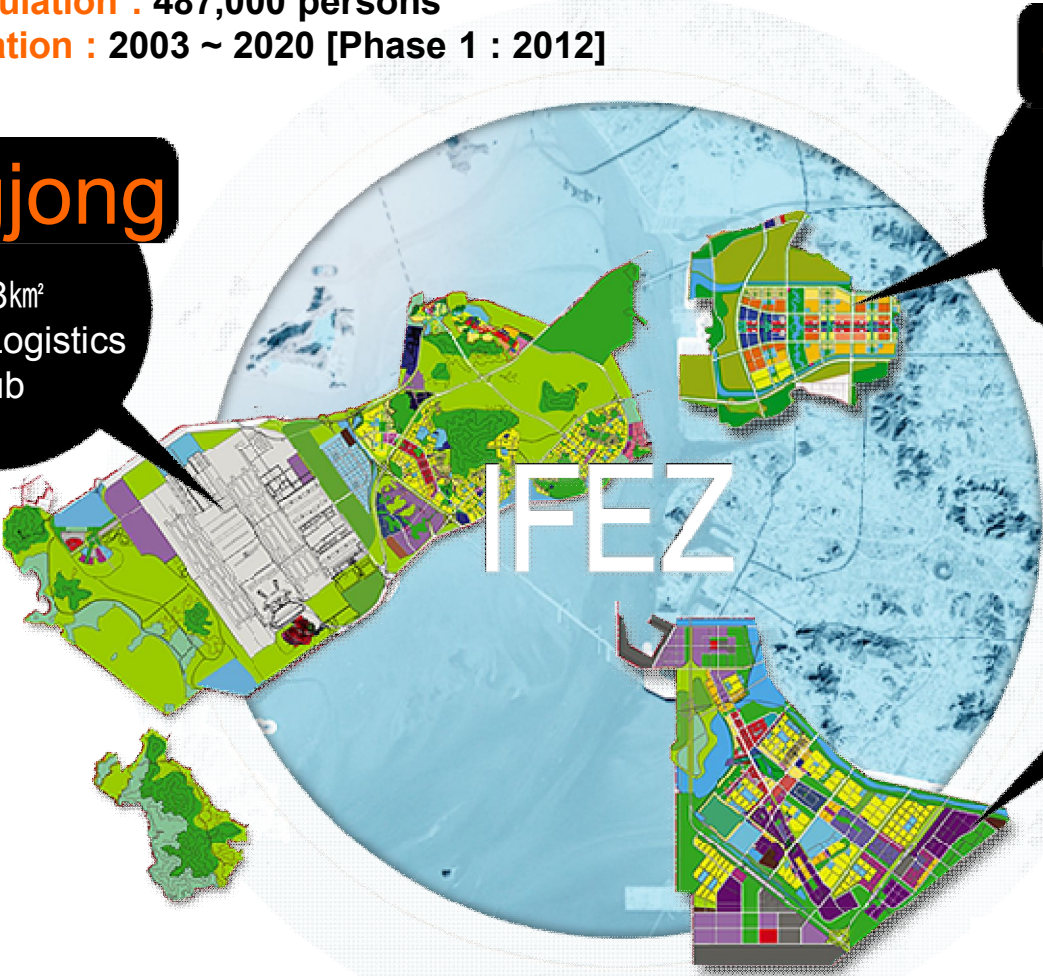

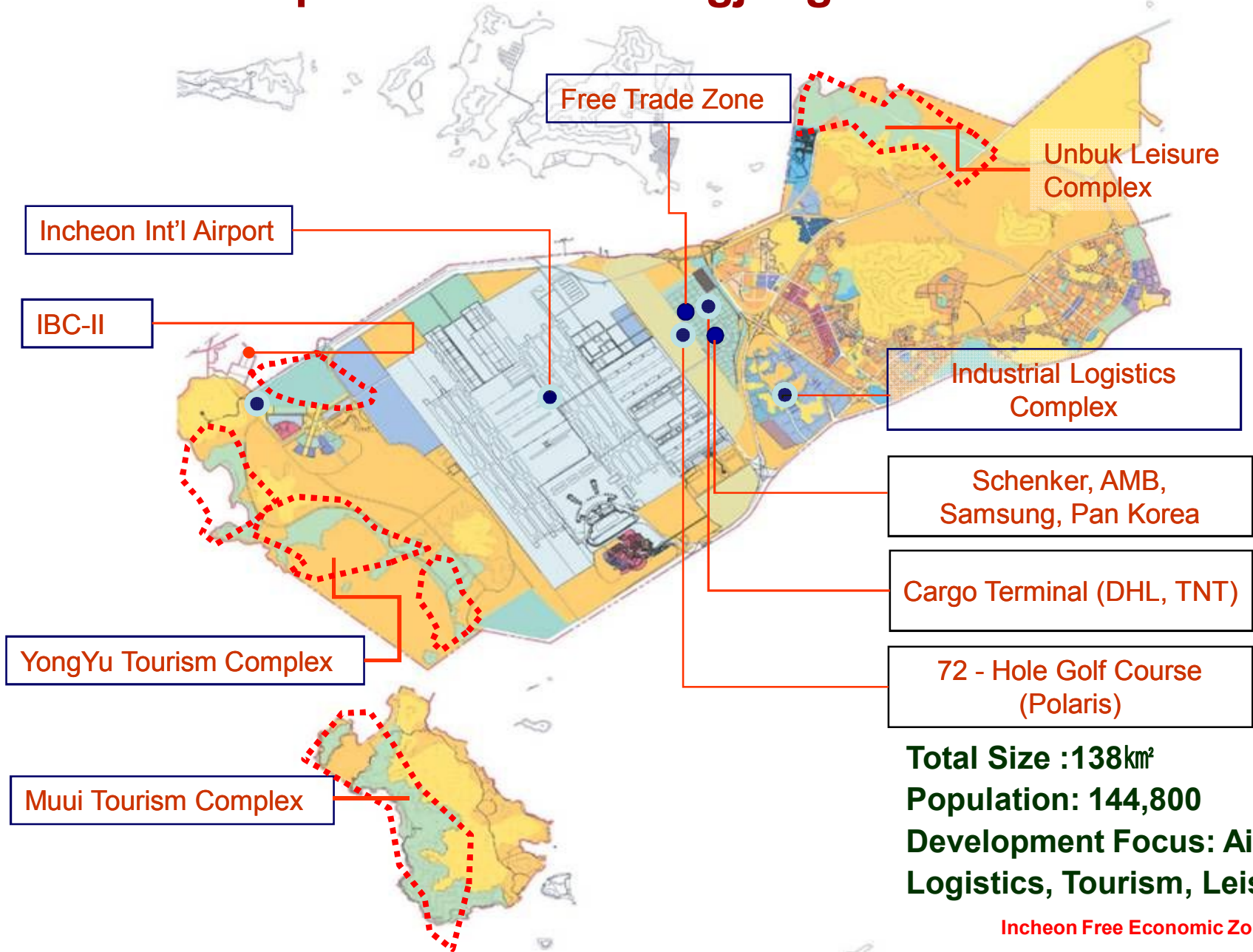

# UNESCAP APCICT

(Asian and Pacific Training Center for Information and Communication Technology for Development)



- First UN agency in South Korea
- Train IT specialists from 62 member countries including North Korea (promotes national image as IT powerhouse)
- US\$10 million provided over next five years (Ministry of Information & Communications - US\$2.5 million, Incheon - US\$5 million plus facilities, in-kind)
- Construct networked city and IT cluster in Songdo Area
